 The Rid and Wendler (2011) framework offers systematic and comprehensive steps to evaluate risk-benefits assessment.

Authors posit that this method offers practical benefits such as enhancing the consistency and accuracy of evaluations, and strike an adequate balance between subject protection and research advancements. Conceptually, the framework also highlights and identifies other unresolved questions in risk-benefit assessment which can stimulate future analyses and investigation.
